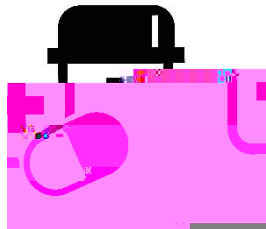

There will be a quiet space available.

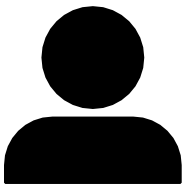


There will be accessible bar lanes at each main bar. Large print menus will be available.

British sign language interpreting performances will be available. Please request this on your application form.



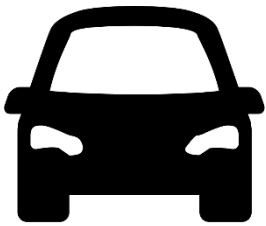
Hearing loops are available at the accessibility box office.

An accessible car park is available. Please request this on your application form.



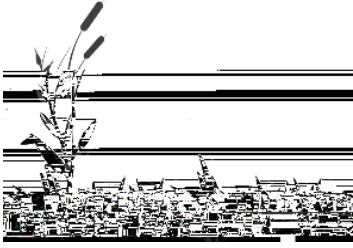
Accessible drop off passes are available. Please request this on your application form.



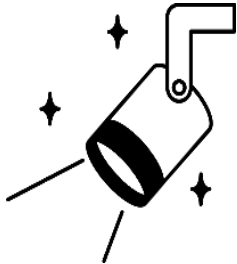

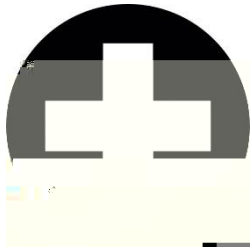
We will send you an accessibility guide before the festival. This will include a photo of the map.



The ground may be grassy and be steep. When wet the ground may be muddy and difficult to walk through.

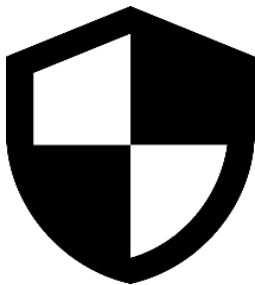


There may be some performances that use smoke machines, lasers, strobe lights, moving lights & fireworks. This may be used at any time.
