While we do not require you to provide us with any special category data as part of your submission, if you decide to share any special category data with us as part of what you write in your submission, the BBC will also collect and process special category data.

At the BBC we are committed to reflecting and representing the diversity of the UK. For some opportunities with BBC Comedy, we will be looking to work with and develop writers, producers, or directors from historically under-represented demographics. To do this, we may ask you to confirm in the Eligibility Questions that you meet the criteria that applies to that opportunity. By confirming your eligibility for the opportunity, you may reveal to the BBC special category data about yourself, for example, if you have a disability.

Special category is data that may reveal information about you such as your:

- Race or ethnicity
- Health
- Religious or philosophical beliefs
- Sexual Orientation

This information will be stored in a way which is not linked to you or your submission and will be used by the BBC only to understand and report on the demographics of talent it works with as part of BBC Comedy.

Whilst you may not meet the eligibility criteria to proceed with a particular opportunity or if you decide not to confirm whether you meet the eligibility criteria for a specific opportunity, you can reply and participate in other opportunities at the BBC.
