

Complaints to the BBC: April 2016

The BBC answered over **16,000** complaints from the audience during April 2016. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints about Radio 4's *Don't Make Me Laugh* on April 21 from listeners who felt jokes relating to the Royal Family and The Queen were inappropriate.

There were also complaints from viewers who were disappointed that *Gardeners' World* wasn't broadcast on April 8 due to coverage of the England v Belgium Women's Euro 2017 football qualifier.
