

Complaints to the BBC: December 2011

The BBC answered over **52,000** complaints from the audience in December 2011. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

The One Show on 30 November attracted a large number of complaints from viewers this month.

There were complaints about the lack of women nominated for the BBC Sports Personality of the Year Award 2011.

There were complaints about the news coverage of proposed changes to the EU treaty with some viewers feeling it was biased against David Cameron while others felt it was biased in favour of David Cameron.
