"Reconciliation" is the theme of *Sunday Worship*, broadcast live from St Anne's Cathedral in Belfast on Sunday 25 April at 8am. The Dean of Belfast Cathedral, the Very Rev Dr Houston McKelvey, leads the service, focusing on reconciliation both in Northern Ireland and South Africa, which is celebrating the 10th anniversary of its first post-apartheid democratic elections.

On Monday 26 April at 9.45am, *Daily Service* comes live from the Chapel of Unity, Methodist College, Belfast, whose Senior Girls' Choir has been Sainsbury Choir of the Year on two occasions. The programme is presented by the Rev Dr Bert Tosh.

Radio Five Live is also at the festival and will provide topical coverage of major events of Music Live.
